CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning course

Qualification

A nationally recognised CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning (603/2498/3). The Course will run for 1 academic year during which learners will be required to spend a minimum of 2 days per week gaining classroom experience and one evening session per week to cover the theory aspect of the course.



Programme dates: 4th September 2018 – 19th July 2019

Evening sessions will take place on Monday's 17:00 – 19:00 at Brompton-on-Swale School (term time only).



Method of Assessment

This is a level 3 course. Learners will be required to compile a portfolio of evidence and written assignments which demonstrates their learning against each of the assessment criteria for the course. They will also have regular visits in school from the course assessors and will receive marking and feedback support during the evening sessions.

Minimum Requirements

The Swaledale Alliance is dedicated to providing training that our local schools will recognise as a high quality qualification. Preference for sponsored places will therefore be given to candidates who have GCSE (or equivalent) in English and Maths at grade C or above. Applicants who do not have GCSE's (or equivalent) but are working towards these qualifications will also be considered.

Cost

The cost for this course is £1650 this includes:

- Course materials
- Personal tutor support
- Assignment marking and feedback
- Assistance with school placement

This does not include a non-refundable registration fee of £120 for all learners at the start of the course.



Sponsorship

We have a limited number of sponsorship placements available which will be allocated through application and interview process. The sponsor school will meet the cost of the course fee, however learners will still need to pay the registration fee of £120. Learners will commit to undertaking their school experience for 2 days per week in that school over the academic year.
